



Pasture Rider Job Description

The Association of Manitoba Community Pastures is seeking to fill two Rider positions in western Manitoba beginning for the 2022 grazing season.

Duties include supporting the day-to-day operations of the Community Pasture:

Livestock Care

- Admit livestock onto the Pasture
- Count and record livestock on enter and exit from pasture
- Sort cattle and place in proper pasture
- Continuous surveillance of cattle during the season
- Treatment of sick or injured cattle
- Remove cattle requiring extra veterinary care
- Distribution of salt and minerals.
- Distribution of bulls
- Round up stray cattle
- Rotate cattle on pasture
- Make sure cattle have adequate forage and water
- Ensure cattle are cared for in a humane manner
- Gather cattle at the end of the season
- Perform predator control work as required

Maintenance and Development

- Inspect and repair fences and corrals prior to and during the grazing season
- Repair and maintain buildings, pasture fixtures, and equipment
- Perform weed control work and treat dugouts as required
- Basic maintenance and repair watering systems

Miscellaneous - Other duties as assigned

Must be willing to supply own horses and tack. Benefits include competitive salary, annual RRSP contribution and health plan.
