tions by writers & philosophers, her art often



Evelyn Knight May 7 to June 11, 2022





This exhibition is presented as a show and sale of Evelyn Knight's works and will chronicle her life as an artist.

Evelyn Knight was born in St. Thomas in 1925. She grew up on College Street and attended Arthur Voaden Secondary School, and at the age of 19, enrolled at Alma College from 1946 to 1948. After graduation, Evelyn married and had four children. Once the children were older, Evelyn began painting full-time, leading to a position teaching painting and drawing at Fanshawe School of Continuing Education for ten years.

This exhibition features works by Evelyn Knight in the Public Art Centre's permanent collection and more than 30 private works available for purchase.

The inspiration for this exhibition comes from a 2016 episode of Revisionist History, by Malcolm Gladwell. The episode, *The Lady Vanishes*, tells the story of the place of women artists (or lack thereof) throughout the history of art and art collecting.

The term on the line refers to the hanging of art. A work of art displayed prominently in an exhibition and at eye level is considered on the line.

For far too long, women artists were not located

on the line or in many exhibitions and public collections. The Public Art Centre has and continues to place importance on collecting and exhibiting the works of women artists, both contemporary and historical.


This permanent collection exhibition is focused entirely on local and regional women artists, their work, and their extraordinary determination to create.



Because the spaces are limited in these classes, the Public Art Centre will offer an additional session in June, if the demand dictates.






