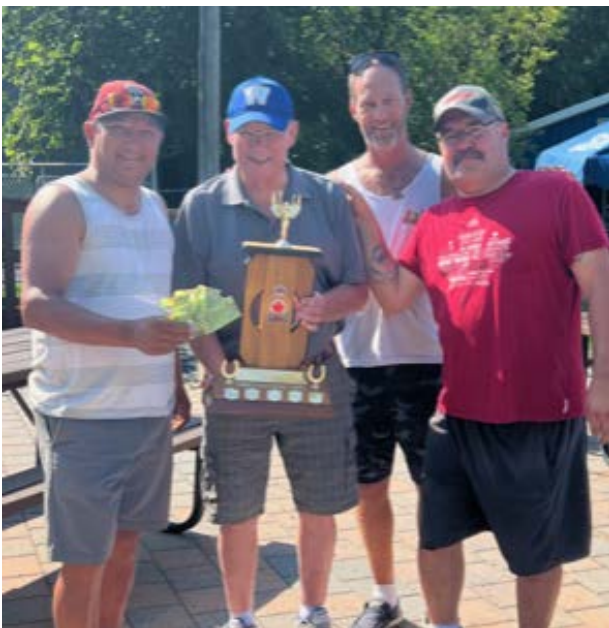


## Sports

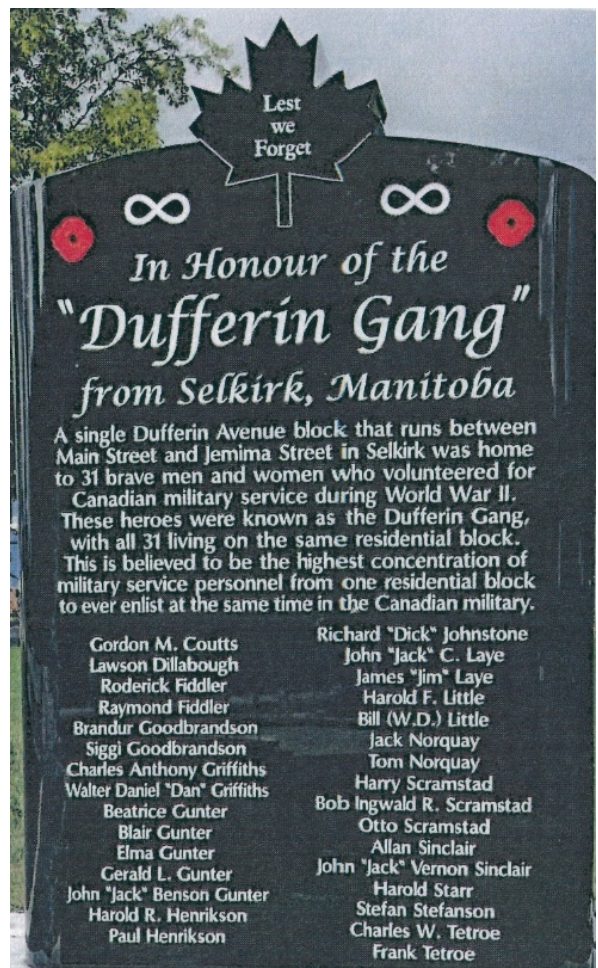
## Dufferin Gang Memorial Tribute
