## Additional information for attending class.

With the new requirements for the Province of New Brunswick, issued by Premier Higgs on Wednesday, September 15th, we are now requiring all staff, trainers and students to provide proof of two vaccinations before entering our classrooms. With this we will also require students to provide a government issued piece of identification and wear a mask indoors in all public spaces, this includes our classrooms. Masks are required to be worn in the classroom throughout the course and when moving in the building. The instructor may remove their mask while teaching if they can maintain physical distancing. There are no exceptions. If you cannot provide proof of vaccination and a valid ID you will be denied access and will be charged for the cost of the course.

## IUPAT DC 39 Online Learning Management System

As a complement to our current Apprenticeship and Safety Training program, the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades District Council 39 is continuing to offer a number of courses online through our **Learning Management System** or **LMS**.

It gives you access to courses such as trade specific upgrades and add-ons to keep your skills sharp or to pick up some more tricks of the trade. We also have WHMIS 2015 plus several other safety courses and many great general information courses as well; most are available in both English and in French.

The LMS tracks all completed courses giving you the ability to keep track of your certifications easier and also print out a certificate as soon as you complete the course. In NB, Fall Protection and Confined Space can be taken as online refreshers provided the previous training was taken in-class and your certificates have not expired.

To take advantage of this service you must meet all the following criteria:

1. You will need to have a valid and up to date mailing address and a valid email address. If you do not have an email address it is simple and free to set up an account on web sites such as [www.hotmail.com](http://www.hotmail.com) or [www.gmail.com](http://www.gmail.com) or [www.yahoo.ca](http://www.yahoo.ca). I will be collecting email addresses during the regular in-class courses but if you are not attending one of these in the near future you can email me at [cbullman@dc39.ca](mailto:cbullman@dc39.ca) expressing your interest in taking an online course.
2. You must be an **active** member of District Council 39, and in good standing.

If you are interested in taking one or more of the online courses and you meet the above listed criteria, please contact me at the training department. I will be mailing out the official training cards upon your completion of the above-mentioned courses provided you meet the criteria mentioned above. Only courses specific to on-site safety and certifications for utilizing regulated machines and vehicles will be added to your card. General courses will not be listed.
