2023 Summer Work Programs – Camp Beaver Tail**

1. The Town of Castor is accepting applications for summer employees under the 2023 Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) program to work from May 1 to Aug. 31, 2021. Hourly wage will range from \$17.00 - \$20.30 dependent upon experience or work history.
2. The Town of Castor is also accepting applications for summer employees to work from July 3 to Aug. 31, 2023. Hourly wage will range from \$15.00 - \$17.91 dependent upon experience or work history. These positions will be dependent on the town receiving grant funding.

Applicants for the position starting May 1 will be required to work with the public works and recreation departments until mid-June. Preparations for camp will begin full time June 16 with campers arriving the first week of July. Work week will be 40-hours Monday-Friday. Under the general supervision of the Community Service Director staff will plan and deliver day programming to Camp Beaver Tail attendees. General cleaning duties, record keeping and organization are key duties of camp staff.

Along with demonstrated leadership ability the successful applicants will have the ability to perform all duties in a safe manner and to maintain harmonious relationships with all members of the public and other staff members. Physical ability to complete duties requiring physical effort and a proven ability to provide excellent service to the public are required.
