- The gas system is reporting a 0.36% loss for 2025.
- The water system is reporting a 17% loss for 2025.

Correspondence

Council received the Winterfest history as information; it was further noted that in 2025 \$5,632.00 had been provided to the Castor and District AG Society Winterfest Committee in the form of in-kind donations.

Council chose to support the Village of Forestburg's request for changes to the Alberta Electoral Boundaries.
