In the council meeting held on Monday, May 11, 2020, it was decided to open the following public spaces:

- ◆ Green Spaces
- ◆ Ball Diamonds for family use (not dugouts or benches)
- ◆ Boat Launch (not gazebo or picnic tables)
- ◆ Campgrounds—limited occupancy
- ◆ Fish Pond

The following places will remain closed:

- ◆ Playgrounds
- ◆ Washrooms/Outhouses
- ◆ Camp Kitchen

These decisions were made regarding the cleaning requirements that are set in place by Alberta Health Services. It is not feasible for a small town like ours to keep up with the cleaning every 3 hours.

Also, please note that NO Town of Castor Recreation equipment will be able to be rented/borrowed/used at this time.
