Are you interested in gaining knowledge of plants, gardens and gardening?

Starting new in March, The Stavely Public Library is hosting a lecture gardening series that will be held in the Library one evening a month. On Thursday, March 9th 7pm to 8:30pm, our guest speaker will be Maggie McIvor, who will be presenting a short presentation and discussion about early seeding, variety choices, indoor propagation methods and tips for getting more production out of small garden spaces.

As a graduate of the ODH Horticulture program at Olds College, Maggie’s had a long career in horticulture pertaining to Landscape maintenance, greenhouse production, Landscape Design and construction. She has now retired from the City of Calgary as a landscape Inspector and Construction manager and now lives in Nanton gardening on a smaller scale with her husband.
