FEATURED BOOKS OF THE MONTH

- **A Gambling Man by David Baldacci(Archer #2)**- Archer, the straight-talking World War II veteran fresh out of prison, returns in this riveting new thriller
- **Win by Harlan Coben**-. Thrilling story that shows what happens when a dead man's secrets fall into the hands of vigilante antihero, drawing him down a dangerous road.
- **Pretty Little Wife by Darby Kane**- Debut author thrills with this twisty domestic suspense novel that asks one central question: shouldn't a dead husband stay dead?

- **Letters across the Sea by Genevieve Graham-** little-known chapter of World War II history, a young Protestant girl and her Jewish neighbour are caught up in the terrible wave of hate sweeping the globe on the eve of war in this powerful love story that is perfect for fans of The Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society.
- **The Bomber Mafia: A Dream, a Temptation, and the Longest Night of the Second World War by Malcolm Gladwell-** An exploration of how technology and best intentions collide in the heat of war- examines one of the greatest moral challenges in modern American history.
- **The Last Thing He Told Me by Laura Dave-** a mystery/domestic suspense about a man living a lie and his wife and daughter who struggle to discover who he really is.
- **Eternal by Lisa Scottoline-** a sweeping, shattering epic of historical fiction fueled by shocking true events, the tale of a love triangle that unfolds in the heart of Rome...in the creeping shadow of fascism.
- **Sooley by John Grisham-** his first basketball novel. Samuel "Sooley" Sooleymon is a raw, young talent with big hoop dreams...and even bigger challenges off the court.
- **When the Stars Go Dark by Paula McLain-** a novel of intertwined destinies and heart-wrenching suspense: A detective hiding away from the world. A series of disappearances that reach into her past.
- **Our Darkest Night by Jennifer Robson-** a story of terror, hope, love, and sacrifice, inspired by true events, that vividly evokes the most perilous days of World War II.
- **21st Birthday by James Patterson (Women's Murder Club #21) -** Detective Lindsay Boxer vows to protect a young woman from a serial killer long enough to see her twenty-first birthday. When young wife and mother goes missing with her baby girl, all eyes are on her husband. He paints her not as a missing person but a wayward wife—until a piece of evidence turns the investigation criminal.
