Under Traffic Bylaw 999, recreation vehicles and trailers cannot be parked on any street in Castor. The only exception to this is while the vehicle or recreation trailer is being loaded or unloaded, and it must be moved immediately after. Extension cords are not to be placed across sidewalks or driveways. Have a look on the Town of Castor's Website for complete details on this or any of our Bylaws.
