B. That an election will be held for the election of a Senate nominee for the purposes of the *Alberta Senate Election Act*;

C. That a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum question(s) under the *Referendum Act*:

- Should Section 36(2) of the *Constitution Act, 1982* – Parliament and the government of Canada’s commitment to the principle of making equalization payments – be removed from the Constitution?
- Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

Voting will take place on the 18th day of October 2021, between the hours of 10:00 am and 8:00 pm.
Voting stations will be located at:

Castor Community Hall (4801 – 48 Ave.)

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one or more pieces of identification that establishes your identity and residence (street address), such as: identification issued by a Canadian government, that contains a photograph of the elector and their name and current address, income or property tax assessment notice, insurance policy or coverage card, Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee, Residential lease, Utility bill (telephone, public utilities, television, gas or water). As required by section 53 of the Local Authorities Election Act.

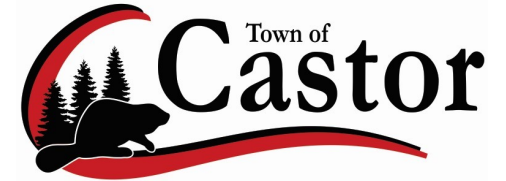
FCSS
