## Slow-Cooker Vegetable Minestrone

- Prep 15 Min
- Total 7 Hr 35 Min
- Servings 12

Savor slow-cooked Italian soup with little effort by letting your slow cooker do all the work! This is one hearty soup recipe the whole family will love.

### **Ingredients**

- **4** cups vegetable broth or Progresso™ chicken broth (from 32-oz carton)
- **4** cups tomato juice
- **1** tablespoon dried basil leaves
- **1** teaspoon salt
- **½** teaspoon dried oregano leaves
- **¼** teaspoon pepper
- **2** medium carrots, sliced (1 cup)
- **2** medium celery stalks, chopped (1 cup)
- **1** medium onion, chopped (1/2 cup)
- **1** cup sliced fresh mushrooms (3 oz)
- **2** garlic cloves, finely chopped
- **1** can (28 oz) Muir Glen™ organic diced tomatoes, undrained
- **1 ½** cups uncooked rotini pasta (4 ½ oz)
- Shredded Parmesan cheese, if desired

### **Steps**

- **1** In 4- to 5-quart slow cooker, mix all ingredients except pasta and cheese.
- **2** Cover; cook on Low heat setting 7 to 8 hours.
- **3** Stir in pasta. Increase heat setting to High; cover and cook 15 to 20 minutes longer or until pasta is tender. Sprinkle each serving with cheese. Note: This recipe was tested in slow cookers with heating elements in the side and bottom of the cooker, not in cookers that stand only on a heated base. For slow cookers with just a heated base, follow the manufacturer's directions for layering ingredients and choosing a temperature.

## Slow-Cooker French

### Onion Soup

- Prep 15 Min
- Total 9 Hr 50 Min
- Servings 8

Our easy Slow-Cooker French Onion Soup is a fantastic winter meal made with little cleanup. How do you make Slow-Cooker French Onion Soup? Start by lining your slow-cooker and cooking the onions. Then add the flour, Worcestershire sauce, sugar, pepper and broth.

### **Ingredients**

#### **Soup**

- **3** cups sliced onions (3 medium)
- **3** tablespoons margarine or butter, melted
- **3** tablespoons all-purpose flour
- **1** tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- **1** teaspoon sugar

- **¼** teaspoon pepper
- **4** cans (14 ½ ounces each) ready-to-serve beef broth

### **Cheesy Broiled French Bread**

- **8** slices French bread, 1 inch thick
- **¾** cup shredded mozzarella cheese (3 ounces)
- **2** tablespoons grated or shredded Parmesan cheese

### **Steps**

- **1** Place Reynolds™ Slow Cooker Liners inside a 5- to 6 1/2 -qt slow cooker bowl. Make sure that liner fits snugly against the bottom and sides of bowl and pull the top of the liner over rim of bowl.
- **2** In lined slow cooker, mix onions and margarine.
- **3** Cover and cook on high heat setting 30 to 35 minutes or until onions begin to slightly brown around edges.
- **4** Mix flour, Worcestershire sauce, sugar and pepper. Stir flour mixture and broth into onions. Cover and cook on low heat setting 7 to 9 hours (or high heat setting 3 to 4 hours) or until onions are very tender.
- **5** Prepare Cheesy Broiled French Bread. Place 1 slice bread on top of each bowl of soup. Serve immediately.
