

Town of Castor Employment Opportunity 2023 Summer Work Programs – Swimming Pool Staff

- 1. The Town of Castor is accepting applications for summer employees under the 2023 Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) program to work from May 1 to Aug. 31, 2021. Hourly wage will range from \$17.00 \$20.30 dependent upon experience or work history.
- 2. The Town of Castor is also accepting applications for summer employees to work from July 3 to Aug. 31, 2023. Hourly wage will range from \$15.00 \$17.91 dependent upon experience or work history. These positions will be dependent on the town receiving grant funding.

Shifts will vary based on operational requirements.

Under the general supervision of the Community Service Director and/or Pool Manager and Assistant Managers, pool staff will perform lifeguarding functions and provide instruction in several aquatic programs and skills, as well as general maintenance.

The successful applicants must demonstrate ability and possess the following current certifications:

- Lifeguard Award
- Swimming Teacher
- Standard First Aid, CPR level C & AED certification.

Along with demonstrated leadership ability the successful applicants will have the ability to perform all duties in a safe manner and to maintain harmonious relationships with all members of the public and other staff members. Physical ability to complete duties requiring physical effort and a proven ability to provide excellent ser4vice to the public are required.
