

November Meeting Summary

Danny Suansing, Engineering Manager of Addison LLC, spoke about 100% Outside Air and Dehumidification Management Systems

The 100% Outside Air and Dehumidification Management is also referred to as a Make Up Air System. They operate continually during occupied mode supplying treated fresh air required as per ASHRAE Standard 62, thus replenishing the amount of air exhausted from the conditioned area.


The treated fresh air can be delivered to the return air system or it can be delivered direct to the space to be conditioned. If it is delivered to the return air, it may not require reheat and control is not critical. However if the treated fresh air is delivered direct to the room more precise control is necessary and reheat for control is required. As per ASHRAE Standards the treated fresh air must be delivered at the lowest dew point possible, typically between 68 to 72 deg F and below 70% RH.

Mr. Suansing proceeded to explain how this achieved and the various types of control that are possible. These include:


- Hot Gas Reheat in an on-off or cycling fashion
- Hot Gas Reheat in a modulating fashion
- Single Compressor system
- Single Compressor system with digital scroll compressor
- Dual Compressor system with Hot Gas Bypass & Hot Gas reheat
- Dual Compressor system with Hot Gas Bypass & hot gas reheat along with Liquid Sub-cooling circuit
- Dual Circuit system as above but with each circuit having two compressors in tandem thus making a 4stage control possible for larger systems
- Winter operation when the compressors don't run but use of direct fired furnace for heat

In addition he also touched upon the systems that are available to improve the EER by incorporating an Energy Conservation wheel in the unit which recovers energy from the exhaust air stream to the fresh air stream in both summer and winter. Improved EER of over 25 is possible in some water source heat pump applications.


