NATURAL GAS PROJECT 2017

Jocko Point, Lower Beaucage, Nova Beaucage/Yellek, Art's Lane

November 21, 2017 – Please be advised that the Natural Gas Project 2017 is coming to an end for the areas mentioned above. Homeowners who may be interested in connecting in 2018 should register online now to let Union Gas know they are interested in the service: <http://www.uniongas.com/naturalgasinquiry>

Once you have an HVAC contractor, they will also need to go online to register their information (such as where the meter will be installed, length of line required, what is being connected – furnace, fireplace, appliances, etc. – and the estimated gas usage).

Completing these steps during the winter months will ensure that Union Gas is aware of the areas where a service line will be required so work can commence early in the season next year. Otherwise, interested customers may have to wait until fall to be connected to the services.

Union Gas will be returning in 2018 to connect homes that have completed their registrations, to extend the services to Yellek Trail (west end) and to install services to Art's Lane.

We would like to thank all homeowners who have waited patiently for the services to be installed, and we thank Union Gas and Aecon for their hard work on getting the registered homes connected.
