MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

PUBLIC HEARING:

- Public Hearing was brought to order at 7:02. The Public Hearing was conducted by Selectmen Medici.
Motion was made and seconded to close the Public Hearing at 7:05, **All were in favor.**
- **Motion made and seconded** to adopt the GA Ordinances for yearly Appendices A-D for the period of October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017. **All were in favor.**

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded to** approve the Meeting Highlights of September 26, 2016. All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- None

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Vicki Carroll, Chairman of the Tibbetts Veterans Memorial Park Revitalization Committee. The Committee has found that the rock wall at the park is in need of extensive repairs so before any changes can be made at the park the Wall must be repaired. The Committee has requested the town pay for the repairs that need to be done to the wall. After some discussion on the matter the Selectmen feel the best way to go about this is to first get a few estimates outlining the repairs that need to be done, along with the cost of those repairs. The estimates would be given to the Budget Committee so they could include the cost of the repairs in the Parks and Recs budget. The Board of Selectmen will write an Article to vote on at the March town meeting.

- Joanne Andrews Presented Drawings for restoration of the windows at the Brick Town Hall. John Cleveland and the architect came up with a plan that would include restoration of the current windows (reglazing and trim replacement) and an inside storm window that would be able to be opened up in the warm weather. The town has three (3) grants that require restoration not replacement, and the group will have a price bid soon.

OLD BUSINESS:

- The mowing contract is ready. An ad will be placed for October 12th and 19th, in the Shopping Guide. All bids need to be received by the Selectmen's office by October 31st, 2016 by Noon.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to approve up to \$800.00 toward the purchase of a new laptop for the Code Enforcement Office along with the Code Enforcement manuals.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Announcements were read by Selectmen LePage and Medici.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- **Motion was made and seconded** to accept the Action, Pending and Bill folders. **All were in favor.**

WARRANTS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Warrants as presented. **All were in Favor.**

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Tony Carroll would like the Board of Selectmen to assess the town's needs for appropriate meeting space where at least 200 people can congregate. Tony would like the board to consider the town's needs for further off in the future rather than looking at things as right now.
- Judy LePage would like the town's people to consider the fact that we need a vault now, because if the building caught on fire, the sprinkler system would ruin the records faster than a fire. If the town bought the Bank Building on Main Street, they could apply for grants to do repairs to this building as well and the Municipal Building could then be opened up to allow for Large Town Meetings.

- **Motion made and seconded** to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
