#### **SUMMARY OF MAY MEETINGS**

Our regular May meeting was replaced by two seminars presented by E. Mitchell Swann, ASHRAE Distinguished Lecturer. Mr. Swann spoke on May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> as part of the technical seminars associated with MEET 2010 (Mechanical, Electrical and Electronic Technologies Show). A combined total of 73 people attended the seminars.

The first seminar, "Design Build – Executing the Project" was based on the ASHRAE Design Build Survival Guide, which Mr. Swann co-authored. He addressed some of the ideas, issues and concerns that arise in the D\B execution model that differ from traditional design or construction and differ for the owner as well. Scope, quality, cost and schedule control are key items which will be addressed in the program. The value of 'selling' the service is only maintained if there is value in the delivery as well.

The next day's topic was entitled "Design Build for Green Buildings – Integrated Delivery of an Integrated Idea". A key component of green design is the merging of the architectural and engineering design effort to yield a more holistic design. Another movement in the industry is in project delivery. Design\build seeks to gain time and cost efficiencies by merging the lines between design and construction. Given that both philosophies – green buildings and design\build – have the integration of services at their core, it is only natural that the two would also merge in the delivery of projects. This seminar will highlight some of the key ideas, elements and issues that are inherent in both approaches and where and how they interface on a project.




We had a few things that distinguished this year from others:

- We sold ASHRAE Research cups as a promotional tool.


I would like to welcome new and past members to the June 19 Lobster Party in Cocagne and remind people to sign up for the golf tournament on August 5.


