Food Security Spotlight

The different Food Security Statuses and how the Government of Canada determines them;

Households can be sorted into one of the following four categories:

Food secure

These households had access, at all times throughout the previous year, to enough food for an active, healthy life for all household members.

Food insecure, marginal

At times during the previous year these households had indications of worry about running out of food and/or limited food selection due to a lack of money for food.

Food insecure, moderate

At times during the previous year these households had indications of compromise in quality and/or quantity of food consumed.

Food insecure, severe

At times during the previous year these households had indications of reduced food intake and disrupted eating patterns.

These categories are determined by the Household Food Security Module, or HFSM, which asks households via a survey a variety of questions aimed to discover how food secure or insecure they are. These questions relate to the quantity, quality, and availability of the households food. For example, a household may be asked how worried they are about running out of food before their next paycheck.
