
ABSTRACT


ASHRAE Guest Speaker at University of New Brunswick

The Chapter Research Promotion Chair, Rob Hoadley, was invited as a guest speaker at the 10th Mechanical Engineering Graduate Student Conference at the University of New Brunswick. The presentation took place on November 12 at Head Hall, on the Fredericton campus of UNB. The presentation was intended as an introduction both to the HVAC industry and ASHRAE and ASHRAE Research.

The presentation began with a description of the history of ASHRAE and the origins of the HVAC industry in North America. The role of ASHVE and ASRE (the founding societies of ASHRAE) in conducting research regarding HVAC topics was integral in developing the rules of thumb and standards we used today. Many of the students were not aware of the origins of air conditioning and refrigeration, early forms of building heating, or even the effects of the energy crisis of the 1970s on building design.

The presentation also provided information on various grants and scholarships available to students through ASHRAE. The Graduate Grant-in-Aid, a \$10,000 award to a graduate student conducting HVAC research, was particularly of interest to the assembled graduate-level students.



Fundamentals of Water System Design


