

June Meeting Overview:

Tony De Santis has been active in the HVAC domain since 1988. As a former graduate of Concordia University's Building Engineering program (HVAC specialization), Tony is also a member of the OIQ (Quebec Order of Engineer's) for the past 18 years. From 1988 until 1996, Tony has worked in numerous mechanical consulting firms in the Montreal area. He specialized in the design of electromechanical HVAC systems for commercial and industrial buildings.

In late 1996, Tony made the transfer to manufacturing by joining Dectron Internationale. He is Dectron's Eastern Canada's Regional Sales Manager covering Ontario, Quebec, as well as the Maritime provinces. His prime interest and function is to assist the network of local distributors and representatives in the design, application and sales of mechanical dehumidification equipment. The use of this equipment is mainly for indoor natatoriums, ice rinks, make-up air, and commercial—industrial markets.


Tony's presentation will cover the following topics:

- Pool Water Chemistry
- Dectron Rule (ASHRAE Standard 62, ductwork design, etc)
- How a mechanical Dehum works (Thermal Flywheel concept)
- Alternate Green Refrigerants (R-407c, R-134A, R-410A)
- ARI Standard 910 (MRE = Moisture Removal Efficiency)

Summary of May Meeting

For our May meeting, Steve Fecica, the Eastern Regional Manager for MGI Technologies Inc. gave a presentation on Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) and Motors in the HVAC Industry. The presentation looked at energy conservation, Affinity laws, and typical VFD applications (pumps and fans). The history of VFDs over the last 25 years was discussed, including the advancements with respect to the evolution of power devices, microprocerssor power, and network communications. Also discussed were the problems experienced with VFDs since they first entered the industry, in particular Harmonics, and how these problems have been addressed. The employing of high efficiency motors throughout the HVAC industry was also discussed.






