

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

April 25, 2016

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

ATTENDEES:

CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

Public Hearing was brought to order. Chairman LePage asked if there were any comments from the audience and hearing none, decided to keep the Public Hearing open until 7:25 p.m. **Motion made and seconded** at 7:30 p.m. to approve the Liquor License for Susan Lazouras DBA, The Peppermill Restaurant. All were in favor. Public Hearing was closed at 7:30 p.m., **Motion made and seconded** and all were in favor.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded** to approve Meeting Highlights of April 19, 2016. All were in favor.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Wade Andrews gave his report for the month of March concerning animal complaints and numbers he responded to. He also explained what happens with a “Dog-at-Large” call. Selectmen Medici would like to review the Dog Ordinance.
- Joanne Andrews spoke about the Transfer Station. She said Mellen & Son would be bringing another container or a truck during holiday weekends for the overflow of household trash at the Transfer Station. Joanne reminded people that used paint can now be taken to the T.S. for disposal and that new containers will be arriving for used clothes and shoes. She mentioned the town is doing fairly well at recycling, but has a long way to go.
- Amanda LePage was unable to attend due to health reasons.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Bids were opened for the paving of several town roads, with the winning (lowest) bid going to F.R. Carroll at \$203,600. The other bids were from Pike at \$234,737 and Dayton Sand and Gravel at \$220,793. **Motion made and seconded** to award the project to F.R. Carroll, Inc. All were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Needed repairs to the Moore Building were discussed. The Board decided they would need to get further information on the scope of the work.
- Selectmen asked Bob Devilleneuve to check the wiring in the building at the ballfield.
- **Motion made and seconded** to approve Gorham Fence to install/repair fencing at the ballfield under Parks & Rec for the cost of \$1,290.00. All were in favor.
- **Motion made and seconded** to spend \$1,800.00 by Parks & Rec for improvements at the ballfield by Robert Libby. All were in favor.
- Board of Selectmen reviewed the letter to the Cummings Foundation. **Motion made and seconded** to sign and send the letter. All were in favor.
- Policy for Specialty Risk Accident for Parks & Rec was approved. **Motion made and seconded.** All were in favor.
- Service call for the Selectmen's Office printer was tabled until next week.
- Used Car Lot Application for *The Shop* was postponed until Lester Williams can bring a sketch of how the vehicles would be parked on the lot.

- Joanne read the Announcements.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Selectmen John Medici wondered, given the recent withdrawal of the Town of Alfred from the 12-Town Group, if the Town of Limerick should pay their annual dues to this organization. Concensus was to pay dues for the year and see what transpires with the group over the next year.
- John brought up the letter the Fire/EMS had sent to Dominic Vermette and Steve Foglio and thought it should not have been allowed. He wants to find out if the Limerick Fire Dept. should answer to, or get approval from the Board of Selectmen for any actions they may take.
- Steve Malmude had responses to some of the points John made regarding the Fire/EMS letter.
- Sonny LePage said he had a visit from Frank Carroll, Sr. this past week and Frank would like to donate three (3) lots of land surrounding the overlook to the town. **Motion made and seconded** to accept the generous gift of the lots. All were in favor.
- Action, Pending or Bill Folders were approved. **Motion made and seconded.** All were in favor.

WARRANTS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the warrants as presented. All were in favor.

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Sean Carroll expounded on Selectmen Medici's concerns regarding the Fire/EMS letter.
