


Greetings from Theatre Ontario

Preliminary Adjudicator - Virginia Reh

Virginia's career embraces directing, acting, teaching, theatre, music theatre, opera, film and television. Founding Co-Director of Script Lab and a former artistic director of the Gryphon Theatre, she has worked with the Shaw Festival, Edmonton, Canadian and Vancouver Opera Companies, Opera Lyra, Tapestry, Toronto Operetta Theatre, Theatre on the Grand and Shakespeare in the Square. Virginia is currently on the Dramatic Arts faculty at Brock University. She has taught at the Banff Festival, Sheridan College, the Opera School (University of Toronto) and Theatre Ontario's Summer Courses. She was Drama Coach and Production Manager of the Canadian Children's Opera Chorus for 14 years and has been Dramatic Consultant to Opera In Concert since 1983. A transplanted New Yorker, Virginia has been a champion of Canadian theatre and lyric theatre. She has adjudicated in every region of the province and adjudicated Theatre Ontario in Sarnia (2006) and Sudbury (1983). Virginia was the WODL Adjudicator most recently in 2010. The last time she was traveling adjudicator was 1993-94. Virginia has worked in communities around Ontario as director, workshop leader and play polisher. Virginia is a past recipient of Theatre Ontario's Maggie Bassett Award, for her outstanding contribution to theatre in Ontario.



Festival Adjudicator - John P. Kelly

In his ten years living in Canada, John P. Kelly has officiated at festivals, workshops and at play polishing in most areas of Ontario. Indeed, John claims to know more of Ontario than most Ontarians. He is a founder member of the Irish Association of Drama Adjudicators and was for years a member of the British Guild of Drama Adjudicators. On arriving to live in Ottawa, he founded his own professional theatre company and recently completed his 30th production in the city. The Capital Critics circle twice named him Best Director for his work and in 2013 was awarded the Best Overall Professional Production Award in Ottawa. He has more nominations than he can count, but he particularly likes to boast that in 2009, of the 50 nominations for the major awards in Ottawa, eleven related to shows directed by himself. Not bad, eh? (He is learning fast to speak Canadian now that he is a proud Canadian citizen!). In late September 2012 John was invited by the Great Canadian Theatre Company to direct the Canadian premier of Marie Jones' newest play Fly Me to the Moon. In 2011, John and his wife became proud Canadian citizens. If it were not for the Canadian winter and the summer mosquitoes, he would acknowledge no better country in which to spend his remaining time on this planet. He lives in hope that climate change will make it warmer soon and that some scientist will learn how to control mosquitoes. He is a friendly animal and answers to the names of John, Sean, John P, and Hey You!
