MINUTES:

- Approve Meeting Highlights of July 30, 2018.
 - **Selectman Thorne made a motion to approve the Meeting Highlights for August 6, 2018. Selectman Richard seconded the motion. All were in favor.**

- **Selectman Andrews stated that this year's assessed taxes are \$155,787.20, down roughly \$12,000.00 from last year.**
- **Select chair LePage suggested that the board look at selling the Alire Drive lots now while the real estate market is good and the weather is nice. Selectman Richard will put together a list of town owned properties together that are not in Lake Arrowhead to be reviewed at a workshop.**
- **Selectman Andrews stated the board should look into establishing a Conservation Committee to handle the Lake Arrowhead lots that can't be sold.**
