IUPAT DC 39, partnered with United Academy, is continuing to offer **Aerial Boom Lift & Scissor Lift Operator Certification –** (**Blended**) training as well as **Counterbalance Forklift & Rough Terrain Forklift Operator Certification – (Blended**) training. To qualify for Aerial lift training, participants must be in good standing with the Union and have a valid NB Fall Protection certificate. Blended learning is a combination of online learning and a hands-on practical evaluation by a United Academy Certified Evaluator (CE). The online theory portion can be done at home. The online theory portion takes 4-5 hours to complete, the hands-on may take 1-3 hours to complete depending on class size. Once you successfully pass the online exam, arrangements will be made for you to complete the practical hands-on portion at a participating local United Rentals location by contacting the training department.
