

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
February 12, 2018

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

Joanne L. Andrews and John M. Medici.

ATTENDEES:

- Mike and Julie Gilpatrick, Steve Malmude, Dottie Richard, Ed Harris, Charlie Pellegrino, Lisa LePage, Nancy Gammon.

CALL TO ORDER:

- Joanne called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- **A Motion was made and seconded** to approve the Meeting Highlights of February 5, 2018.
All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Mike Gilpatrick – Mike gave a report regarding the excess iron in the town's water. Due to the high iron content in the water the well was flushed over the weekend and the Water Department suggest that the Limerick residents remove the screens from their faucets and flush their water lines in their houses.
Mr. Gilpatrick will be looking into having an engineer and a hydrologist do some studies of the system and see what needs to be done to update it.
Mr. Gilpatrick stated that the town's water is well within the state levels and passes as safe to drink.
- Lisa gave a Parks & Rec. Report and wanted to remind everybody about the Sledding Party on Saturday February 17th. Come enjoy lite refreshments and sledding.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Chairperson Andrews stated that the Warrant must be completed and signed by February 26th in order to be hung for ten days before the Annual Meeting.
 - The Select board will have the warrant ready to be signed on Tuesday February 20th at the Selectmen's Meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

- The Ad for the Public Hearing was approved to be placed in the Reporter as well as the Shoppers Guide.
- The Selectmen signed the Notice of Public Hearing, to be hung at the Limerick Municipal Building, Limerick Supermarket and Limerick Post Office.
- **A Motion was made by Selectmen Medici to approve the sale of Map 39 Lots 4 and 5. Select chairperson seconded the motion. All were in favor.**

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Steve Malmude would like to volunteer to teach swimming and lifesaving classes during the summer, and has requested the town reimburse him for the cost of the WSI certificate.
- Lisa LePage explained that the Rec. Department doesn't have the budget to start another activity right now. Lisa is still looking into the costs of starting up the swim lesson program but is not ready yet.

PENDING AND CORRESPONDENCE:

- Select Chair Person Andrews and Selectmen Medici confirmed that the town will continue the insurance policy with P&C for the athletes with Parks & Recs. and also the Builders Risk policy on the Snowmobile club building.
- Select chairperson Andrews asked Charles to have the fire department to look at the stuff in the basement of the Brick Town Hall and see what needs to be done to clean it up.
- Selectmen Medici stated that the fire escape should be looked at by a fire escape engineer.
- Selectmen Medici stated that he will schedule cleanings with J.P. Carroll fuel co.

- John read the announcements.

WARRANTS:

- **A Motion was made and seconded to accept the warrants as presented. All were in favor.**

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Nancy Gammon wanted to ask about the Article regarding money for the fire department. Nancy asked about the condition about the existing fire department and the ownership of the equipment. Nancy also asked why Selectmen Andrews abstained from voting for the transfer of funds to the account designated account for the fire department building.
 - Selectmen Medici stated that the article to be voted on is just to set the money aside for future use of a fire department building, it is not to be spent until the town has voted on a bid or design package.

- **A Motion made and seconded** to adjourn the meeting. **All were in favor.** The Meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
