



IMPORTANT NATURAL GAS PROJECT 2017

Jocko Point, Lower Beaucage "Aid to Construct"

December 8, 2017.

Please be advised that an update was provided by Union Gas of all homes that have connected to the natural gas services during the 2017 Project. From the number of homes that have connected and will be connecting in 2018 taken them into account the minimum 70% (201 homes) was not reached. There is a short fall of 51 homes still to connect between both areas to reach the minimum 70%.

The aid to construct will be based on a 70% connection rate which is calculated to be \$1,989.87 per home. An account has been created by NFN Finance Dept for those that wish to pay in full immediately.

For the homeowners that have selected the 3 or 5 year interest free loan must add one 2% admin fee above the minimum aid to construct cost. An account will be created to set up the payment plans which you will be notified in the near future of the date selected for monthly payments. The loan agreements can be paid in full at any time without penalty.

For the homeowners that plan to connect in 2018, Union Gas will be returning. The homeowner selects an HVAC contractor that is TSSA approved and once they entered your information on the Union Gas website you are then in line to be connected. If this is done throughout the winter the service line should be

installed no later than June 30, 2018. Please keep in mind that the "Promissory Note" and "Aid to Construct" will still apply to connect to the services.

On behalf of NFN I would like to thank all homeowners that have waited patiently for the services to be installed, thank Union Gas and Aecon for their hard work on getting the registered homes connected.
