# **September Program**

**EcoCute CO<sub>2</sub> Trans-Critical Heat Pumps:** As Canada is going green, there is growing interest in recovering heat. There are many heating demands which vary from low temperature to high temperature (up to 90°C). Conventional heat pumps use either CFC or HCFC refrigerants which are not environmentally friendly, given their high Ozone Depletion Potential (ODP) and Global Warming Potential (GWP) points. These refrigeration cycles are designed to operate as sub-critical packages.

EcoCute is an industry term for heat pumps using CO<sub>2</sub> as a refrigerant. CO<sub>2</sub> is a natural refrigerant which has many advantages over synthetic refrigerants. Designed to operate as a trans-critical system, CO<sub>2</sub> EcoCute heat pumps offer many advantages, including 90°C water and higher Coefficients of Performance. The EcoCute system won the ASHRAE Innovation Award at MEET 2010.

Quinn Vo, P. Eng., a Registered Professional Engineer in Ontario, will present the program. He has over 19 years in industrial refrigeration, including field experience, design, production, and application. Quinn has been with Mycom North America since 1997 and is currently Corporate Engineer, and located in Mississauga, Ontario.




The tournament raised \$1,800.00 for ASHRAE research and promotion and for the first time, we actually finished in the black (slightly).
