## Delegations

A presentation was received from the Castor Winterfest Committee. Winterfest will occur February 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Council approved the associated requests (snow clearing, snow placement and funds to support prizes) with the exception of financially supporting the fireworks show.

A presentation was received from Paintearth Economic Partnership Society outlining their programs and projects.

## Financial Updates

Council received the Cash Statement for the period ending November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The Town of Castor continues to maintain expenditures within budget and remains on target for the year.

## Gas and Water Reconciliation Reports

- The gas system is reporting a 0.09% loss for 2025.
- The water system is reporting a 16% loss for 2025, with losses trending downwards.

## Land Sales

Council moved to relist Industrial Lots – Plan 762 0431; Lot 4 and Plan 762 0431; Lot 5 at \$30,000 per parcel.

## Recreation Fees

Recommended by the Castor Recreation Board, Council reviewed and set the fees for 2026 in the following areas: Ball, Pool and Summer Camp.

## Other

Council chose not to send a delegation to the Eastern Route Rising: Tourism and Economic Power Summit.

## Bylaw 1103 – Schedule “D” Solid Waste Disposal Rates and Service Fees

Council passed the amendment to Bylaw 1103 – Schedule “D” Solid Waste Disposal Rates and Service Fees; setting the rates for 2026, 2027 and 2028.
