

BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Meeting Minutes

April 29, 2019

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the Meeting at 7:05PM with the flag salute.

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

MINUTES:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the minutes for April 22. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Bob Richardson, Road Commissioner, talked about the cleaning of the sand off the roads and he said that they had started this day (April 29). Dottie asked if he thought about getting a street sweeper and Bob told her that it wouldn't get the shoulders as well as it does doing it the way they have been doing it. Wendy asked if Emery Corner Road was going to be done and Bob said it would be. Sue McIntyre asked about how many of the roads were going to be cleaned off and Bob told her that all the roads would be done.
- Jason Johnson, Fire Chief, told the Board that the apparatus was all up to date and all of the trucks maintenance was done. Dottie **motioned** to approve the paperwork that Jason submitted for Fire investigation. Wendy **second**. **All** were in favor. Dottie **motioned** to approve the vehicle maintenance, the SOG Ops 1-100. Wendy **second**. **All** were in favor.

- The Board discussed the York County Budget Caucus reconvening on Wednesday and it was decided that Wendy would go as the elected official.
- Sonny told everyone that a crew had gone up and cleaned all the knocked down trees off of the town beach. Also the Board decided that Rick would open the gates in the morning and Mike Farrell would close them in the afternoon.

Wendy told him that it is legal to give employees an opt out choice and Dottie said that other towns have done it as well and it is a perk for the employees. Judy LePage got up and said that it would cost the taxpayers less if more employees went with the opt out portion. It passed with a 2 to 1 vote.
- Wendy **motioned** to sign the submitted bill by J & S Masonry for the \$480. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.

WARRANT:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the warrant as written. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.

HEARING OF THE CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude thanked the guys who went to clean up the trees.
- Ed Morgan got up to ask about the health insurance thinking that it had been turned down but was told that it had been approved because nor Sonny or Joanne could vote so it was a majority vote.

- Wendy **motioned** to adjourn. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.
- The Meeting was adjourned at 7:40PM.
