SNOW REMOVAL



Stavely Town Council and staff would like to remind everyone now that winter is upon us to please adhere to Bylaw No. 764:

18.1) The owner of a land adjacent to a sidewalk shall remove or cause to be removed and cleared away all snow, ice, dirt, debris or other materials from that part of the sidewalk.

18.3) Removal shall be completed to bare pavement standard, for the entire width of the sidewalk, within 24 hours of the time when the snow, ice, dirt, debris or other material was formed or deposited thereon.

** There are snow removal companies for hire please contact the Town office for more information.

The Town would ask that you please shovel or blow snow onto your own property and not on the streets. Your cooperation as always is most appreciated!

Garbage & Recycling Reminder

Just as sorting recyclables is important so too is ensuring the proper disposal of our garbage. A friendly reminder to all residents that metal, wood products, electronics, paints, tires, and other mixed dry refuse are **not** to be placed in your garbage for weekly pickup – these items are considered dry waste and your weekly garbage pickup is for “wet” waste only. **Please do not take any items containing Freon (water coolers, air conditioners, fridge, etc.) to the recycling.**

The Town has seen a HUGE increase in cardboard recycling please flatten your cardboard to allow for much needed space.

Garbage, Sewer & Water

The Town of Stavely Council has completed an in-depth review of the services it provides to its residents. The following rate changes have passed first reading of Bylaw 836 and 838 on November 23, 2020.

Effective January 1, 2021 a change in the following rates:

Garbage:	Residential monthly charge will increase to:	\$20
	Non Residential monthly charge will increase to:	\$25
	School monthly charge will increase to:	\$34
Sewer:	Sewer rates will remain the same	
Water:	Residential monthly charge will increase to:	\$34
	Non Residential monthly charge will increase to:	\$45
	Residential allowable consumption will decrease from:	27 m3 to 20 m3
	Non Residential allowable consumption will decrease from:	90 m3 to 50 m3
	Non Residential over allowable consumption will increase to:	\$1.50 / m3
	Inactive, vacant properties & winter travelers per month	\$20
	Unmetered services per month	\$200
