A Brief History of General Motors

Robert McLaughlin's Carriage Company, which formed in 1867, merged with Chevrolet and was then sold in 1918 to become General Motors of Canada. Robert's sons, R.S. (Sam) and George agreed to the proposed terms and remained onboard to run the new company, as President and Vice President respectively.

During the First World War, Oshawa's auto industry had provided many of the military vehicles required by the Allied Nations, and in turn, the wartime effort assisted in the development of expanded facilities. Following WWI, new factory plant units were erected to support the production of the newly acquired automobile contracts.

General Motors aided the town of Oshawa greatly by having several roads widened and resurfaced, by purchasing land and donating Lakeview Park to the citizens of Oshawa, and by sponsoring various sports teams. Although in 1928 the company experienced record production figures, the following year's stock market crash and resulting depression had a serious impact on the automobile industry. General Motors was not immune to this affect.

In 1938, 31 years after the company's first car was built. This same year, the company began to build and test various army trucks and combat vehicles. Being dedicated to the war effort, R.S. McLaughlin had approved the request brought before him the preceding year by the Department of National Defense to construct military equipment. Tests had revealed the efficiency and reliability of the vehicles produced by General Motors and this is what prompted the request from the Department of National Defense. By 1942 production on passenger vehicles came to a halt and full wartime production ensued.

General Motors of Canada was no stranger to military production; it had created many weapons and vehicles in the first and second World Wars. In 1975 GM of Canada began construction on trucks for

the Department of National Defense. It only took one year to modify the assembly line so that the trucks could be produced on the same line as the regular commercial vehicles.

GM is firmly committed to providing safe working conditions and to the preservation of the environment. In 1988 GM in Oshawa was recognized for its safety record; the Minister of Labour presented the company with an Associations Award of Excellence. In 1993 the company received an Environmental Citizenship certificate due to voluntary efforts to reduce their use, production, and release of toxic substances in their manufacturing process. Their wastewater treatment plant has been named state of the art.

The North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) between the U.S., Canada and Mexico has enabled GM of Canada to boost its production capacity considerably. Today GM of Canada has the ability to manufacture more than one million units a year. By shipping about 90 percent of those vehicles to the United States it contributes considerable export earnings to our country. GM of Canada is this country's leading producer of passenger cars, trucks, locomotives and automobile components.
