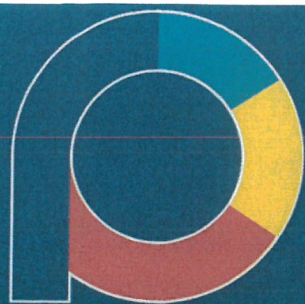


Mary Jane Apcar donated a new bicycle which she had won recently to Laren, the youngest member of our Syrian Family. Thank you, Mary Jane!
