
A social hour will begin at 5:00 PM with a cash bar, followed by the panel discussion at 6:00 PM and Dinner at 7:00 PM.

# **Summary of MEET 2012 ASHRAE Seminars**


Distinguished Lecturer, James L. Newman, presented two well-received seminars at this year's MEET Show. On May 2<sup>nd</sup>, about 100 people filled the enlarged seminar room to overflowing for a presentation on **Transforming an Older Facility into a High-Performance Building.** Jim stressed the importance of energy audits and retro-commissioning in bringing a facility up to spec in HVAC efficiency, service water and lighting systems. He explained the problem when building owners consider only a simple payback period, and not life-cycle costing. Today, there are many methods of improving operation of older equipment, as well as new methods of cleaning, repairing and optimizing older equipment rather than replacing it. Energy efficiency and better indoor environmental quality (IEQ) are only two of many areas which should be considered to make a building more attractive to employees as well as to existing or potential tenants.

The next day, some 55 people attended the seminar entitled **Green Practices and ASHRAE Standards 90.1 and 62.1 – How to Have a Healthier, More Profitable Building with Better Mechanical/Electrical Design (and More Thought to the Building Envelope).** Mr. Newman described how to surpass the ASHRAE Energy and Ventilation Standards to refine and better maintain mechanical and electrical/lighting systems. Good integration of design between the architect and the mechanical and electrical engineer can lead to an enhanced design that not only is more energy efficient but also contributes to better indoor environmental quality. Using these concepts can lead to LEED® certification at minimal additional cost, and often at no extra cost. This will help conserve energy, enhance the health, well-being, and productivity of a building's occupants, and save money for the building owner.






# ASHRAE NB/PEI Chapter 40th Anniversary Golf Shirts

# **Chapter 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration**




