

## BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

July 18, 2016

### MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

#### CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

#### MINUTES:

- Selectman Medici **made a motion** to accept the Highlights of July 11, 2016 as presented. Chairman LePage **seconded** the motion. All were in favor.

#### SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Wendy Thorne gave an overview of the Fire Ordinance Committee and presented the Selectmen with a new Municipal Fire Ordinance to be reviewed by the Town Attorney
- Lovedy Alexander President of the Research Club. Requesting permission to put a cement bench under the tree in the front of the Municipal Building in memory of Ruth Floyd, a Research Club member who passed away last year. They will find a way to anchor it down. Selectman Medici **motioned** to approve the Research club to put a 6' bench in front of the Municipal Building. Chairman LePage seconded.

#### DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Cindy Smith gave the Library report for the Month of June: 811 people used the Library, 1120 books were circulated – 56 audio books, 277 DVD's, 171 people used the computers, 15 programs with an attendance of 112 people. Artist of the Month is Amanda Anges who does acrylic and water color, Mrs. Secunde is doing a program with B-Bots – robots that the children at the Line School use. Friends of Limerick Library will be doing a program starting Thursday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM and will be the third Thursday of each month. People can sign up for that. Book discussion on August 8<sup>th</sup> "What Alice Forgot"

- Chief McLean gave the Fire report. They received the Stop and Slow signs from MMA. Smokey the Bear sign installed by Rt 11 and Emery Corner Rd., possibly make a sign for the Public Beach with the extra space on the sign. 33 EMS calls with 36 patients. They will be receiving a 22.5 generator for free from Kennebuck.
- Amanda LePage more soccer sign ups Tuesday July 19<sup>th</sup>, Monday Aug 1<sup>st</sup> and Wed Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> Sat Aug 6. Received late notice and resubmitted bill for the movie licensing. John talked to Cindy about being able to utilize this license. Gave Selectmen list of volunteers for a background check. They expect to receive more applications. They need to contact Derek Welch to have the ball field mowed before July 31<sup>st</sup>. Meeting nights changed to Tuesday nights. Next meeting Tuesday August 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM

### OLD BUSINESS:

- The speed sign will be picked up by someone from the Fire Department on Sunday July 24<sup>th</sup> from Hollis. Discussion about where to put it. On hill at first.

### NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussion about mileage reimbursement raising it from \$.44 per mile to \$.55 per mile. Dean LePage stated that generally the Town keeps the mileage at what the State does. The State is currently at the \$.44 per mile. Chairman LePage feels the Budget Committee should look at it.
- General Assistance hours will be changed to Mondays from 6 to 7 PM. Selectman Medici made the **motion** to change the hours, Chairman LePage seconded.
- Selectman Medici made the **motion** to change the Request for Document form as discussed. Chairman LePage seconded. Discussion is to change estimated time from 48 hours to 5 days and to also change the charges to reflect the first hour free.
- Fuel bid announced to be advertised in the Shoppers Guide for three weeks. Bids to be returned unsealed by August 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Chairman LePage thanked Diane Hamilton for her time with the Town. Job posting for Secretary to the Board of Selectmen to be posted for three weeks in the Shoppers Guide and returned unsealed by August 15<sup>th</sup>.

### OTHER BUSINESS:

- Tim and Tawney Mann requested the Town to remove a dead tree. Chairman LePage will turn it over to the Tree Warden Aaron Carroll. Aaron came in and had a discussion about the tree in the cemetery that he received a quote from Chris St. Saviour, a licensed arborist. He will get another quote from Chris for both jobs.
