

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN**  
**Meeting Minutes**

**June 17, 2019**

CALL TO ORDER: Joanne opened the meeting with the pledge at 7:05PM.

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

MINUTES:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the minutes for June 3. Gil **second**. **All** were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Mike Gilpatrick, Code Enforcement Officer, gave his report for the month of May.
- Joe Parsons, Recreation Director, gave his report and also brought up setting up a camera and TV so the parents can see the kids during dance classes. He also asked for a key to the Municipal Building for himself and a Brick Town Hall key for the dance instructor. Dottie **motioned** to order 6 more keys to have on hand. Gil **second**. **All** were in favor. And the Board agreed to give a Municipal Building key to Joe and a Brick Town Hall key to the dance instructor. Steve Malmude made a comment about understanding having parents hovering around.
- Gil Harris, Solar Committee Representative, updated everyone on what was going on with the committee.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Joanne mentioned approving the insurance for basketball, swimming, and soccer. Dottie **motioned** to renew the policy. Wendy **second**. Wendy asked what the price was for each child. Joanne said that it is \$3.16 for each child and it would be about \$436.08 and last year was \$632. **All** were in favor.
- Gil **motioned** to sign the deeds for map 41 lots 22, 75, and 262. Wendy **second**. **All** were in favor.
- Wendy **motioned** to sign the Assessors Return. Sonny **second**. Gil asked what it was compared to last year. Last year it was \$155,787.20 and this year it is \$158, 859.12, about 2,800 more this year. **All** were in favor.
- Wendy brought up having the health insurance article rewritten and will have it ready for next week.

NEW BUSINESS:

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- Sonny **motioned** to reject the Pratt and Son's, INC bid and to return their bond. Wendy **second. All** were in favor.
- Mowing contract being put out to bid the Board discussed other things being changed and added so they decided to put it off for a week.
- Snowplow contract for town owned properties, they decided to look this through and put it off until next week. Wendy asked what was going to happen with the field behind the Municipal Building and Dottie said that it should be added to the mowing contract. Sonny said that usually Bob Richardson hires someone to do along the sides of the road and whoever does that usually does the back field. Joanne asked if they had gotten permission to enter into a more than one year contract and Dottie said yes for both contracts.
- The Board discussed having an Executive Session for Property Tax Abatement and they decided on June 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:45PM before the meeting.
- Wendy **motioned** to approve the paid personal time off request for Courtney. Dottie **second. All** were in favor.

WARRANT:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the warrants as presented. Dottie **second. All** were in favor.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Dottie read the announcements.

ADJOURN MEETING:

- Dottie **motioned** to adjourn. Wendy **second. All** were in favor.
