Castor Cart Collection Guidelines

Set Your Cart Out Properly!

Cart Placement

- Place carts **ON THE ROAD**, not on the curb or sidewalk
- Keep at least **3 feet (1 metre)** clear on all sides
- Ensure **overhead clearance** - keep away from low branches, wires, or overhangs



Collection Time

- Carts out by **7:00 AM**
- Collection between **7:00 AM - 5:00 PM**
- Pickup times may vary



Cart Lids & Spacing

- Lids must be **fully CLOSE**.
- No overflowing or extra bags
- Clear snow & obstructions around carts



Do Not Do This!

- Don't block with parked cars
- Don't place on snowbanks
- Don't wedge between objects



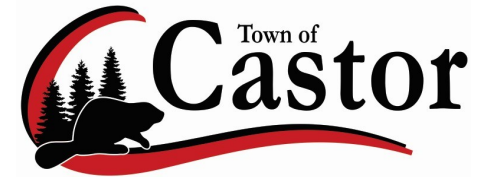
Carts must be **VISIBLE, ACCESSIBLE, and SAFE** to collect!



Collection day is on Fridays between the hours of 7:00am—5:00pm.

Please ensure the wheels of your cart are towards the curb.
