CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded to** accept the Meeting Highlights of November 1st, 2016. All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Mike Gilpatrick presented the Code Enforcement Office report for the month of October.

OLD BUSINESS:

- **Motion made and seconded to** approve Sonny to contact Ford Motor Company to reactivate the FIN account in order to receive the concession discount on cost of the New Ambulance. **All were in favor.**
- Signed Lori Jo Rich's training application that was approved last week.
- Signed CMP Pole Permit for Code Enforcement Office.

- **NEW BUSINESS:**

- **Motion made and seconded to** approve \$49.00 dollars for an annual membership with Staples savings plan. **All were in favor.**
- **Motion made and seconded to** approve up to \$800.00 dollars from the technology account to replace a computer that has quit working in the code enforcements office. **All were in favor.**
- **Motion made and seconded to** award the Washington Street Sidewalk Snow Removal contract to Welch Services, **All were in favor.**

- Judy LePage presented the results of the Presidential Election; a copy of the results can be picked up at the Municipal Office. As a reminder the town needs to do something about providing a new place to hold voting as our Municipal Building does not provide enough sq. footage for the amount of voting booths that are required.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Announcements were read by Selectmen Andrews and LePage.

WARRANTS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Warrants as presented. (as soon as John could go through it) **All were in Favor.**

OTHER BUSINESS:

- The Rec department has requested funds to purchase supplies for Christmas crafts. The selectmen requested the checks be written for the exact amount before being given to the Rec department.
- John inquired as to why the town is being asked to pay \$1,000.00 to cut the manhole covers out of the asphalt on Main Street. The manhole covers were paved over many years ago and now that the Town is looking into replacing sewer lines they need access to the manholes.
- The Tibbetts Park Revitalization Committee had their site walk Saturday and 4 contractors attended that were interested in submitting bids. They were given 2 weeks to submit their bids.
- The Municipal Building had a significant water leak over the weekend; please use caution when at the Municipal Building as there is equipment in the hallways being used to dry out the flooring. Should you need to use the restroom you will need to use the Men's room in the basement.
- Somehow the posts at the Tibbetts Memorial Park were pushed over and need to be repaired or replaced. The selectmen are suggesting that no banners be hung on the chains.
- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Action, Pending and Bill folders. **All were in favor.**

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Brian Saulnier, President of the Fire Department Auxiliary Committee would like to remind people that December 3rd, is the annual Christmas in Limerick and the Fire Department will be hosting "Cookies with Santa" and they are requesting Cookie donations, Cookies can be dropped off at the Fire Department Saturday between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.
- **Motion made and seconded** to replace the American Flags on Main Street with Holiday Flags. **All were in favor.**
