September Meeting

The Phase 2 work at the Moncton Hospital involves interior finishes and fit-ups for the new four-level addition to the hospital, as well as construction of an atrium linking the existing building and services to the new addition. Exterior site work and landscaping will also be completed, and hospital accessibility will be improved.

Renovations to the current structure are also part of Phase 2, and include new connecting corridors, two new teaching boardrooms, new washrooms, and upgrades to the roof. The \$47-million modern and innovative ambulatory care, new trauma and emergency department, and state-of-the-art laboratory is a major trauma and critical-care referral centre, this project will enhance the care we provide to patients from New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island and northern Nova Scotia.
