

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
January 29, 2018

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

Joanne L. Andrews, John M. Medici and Roland C. Lepage.

ATTENDEES:

- Jason Johnson, Dottie Richard, Deedee Tibbitts, Ed Morgan, Ricky Richardson, Frank Carroll II, Lisa and Dean LePage, Judy LePage, Steve Malmude, Bill Jones.

CALL TO ORDER:

- Joanne called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- Selectmen Medici made a motion to table the Meeting Highlights of January 22, 2018 for some corrections to be made. Selectmen LePage seconded the motion. All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Lisa LePage – Parks and Rec department report. There setting up adult bad mitten at the Line School, Thursday night adult basketball is in its second week.
- Lisa wanted to talk about her budget for parks and rec, and the growth of the department.
 - Four years ago they only had Soccer and basketball and basketball was almost canceled.
 - Now they have Soccer pre-k through grade twelve and an adult team. Three weeks of skills and drills, indoor soccer Dec. through March,
 - The basketball has grown from first through sixth grade to pre-k through eighth grade.
 - They have the ice-skating wring with the assistance of the fire department.
 - They implemented the back-ground checks of which are being use for town as well.
 - They still do the Village Christmas.
 - They do sledding party with the community.
 - They have done the movie nights and days in the community room.
 - They did the community cook out last summer with the Maine Life Gate Church.
 - They created a community Rec. Face Book page.
 - They have gone from sixty eight players to over one hundred forty soccer players, that's approximately a forty percent growth.
 - They have done a cleanup of Boy Scout Island and added three new picnic tables and a new sign, with the help of Maine Life Gate Church.
 - They had a meet your local hero's day

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- They've upgraded the ball field and added mulch around the jungle gym which hasn't been done in twelve years.
- They've added a new well and irrigation system, new sod and brushed hogged more area, along with the help of Shaker Valley and along with a lot of donations.
- They added a new bike rack, got the fence fixed and bought some new equipment that will be put in, in the spring, including new swings.
- They've had the bleachers repaired, put in new benches and goals, bought new soccer balls.
- They've added the adult sports teams and looking into a new tumbling program.
- Massabesic Soccer coach wants to join forces with limerick in order to grow.
- Lisa would like to know where the Budget Committee wants the Parks and Rec. department to grow.
- Select chairperson Andrews inquired with Lisa about a bill from the school and asked Lisa to check with Laura and make sure it was correct.
- Jason Johnson – Fire Department wanted to submit a copy of an RFP for review that Ed Morgan has worked on, to be put out for construction of the new fire station. It has some tentative dates and they would like it to be submitted to the attorney and then get some feedback from the board.
 - Selectman Medici asked if they wanted something to happen before March. Jason's reply was no.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Frank Carroll II and Joanne spoke before the meeting and there will be a warrant article, to be voted on at town meeting, requesting expansion of another 175' X 300' of parking space to be put behind the snow mobile club.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Selectman Medici made a motion to approve the signing of the Municipal Quitclaim Deed without Covenants for: Nancy Asbreuk, Map 42 Lots 315, 316 and 319.
 - Selectman LePage seconded the motion. All were in favor.

PENDING AND CORRESPONDENCE:

- Select Chairperson Andrews read the correspondence from MMA regarding the current coverage limit and insurable value on all of the town's properties. MMA uses estimator software that calculates building values by Marshall & Swift and have found that our values were all low. MMA has raised the coverage to reflect new values on the town's properties, at no extra expense to the town at this time.
- John Cleveland is working with Jason up at the town hall and they are hoping that they get everything done in time for Annual Town Meeting.

- Joanne presented the Liability Insurance Program offered through MMA for individuals that would want to use the Brick Town Hall.
 - Selectman LePage made a motion to require individuals to purchase Liability Insurance and provide the Town with evidence of insurance.
 - Selectman Medici seconded the motion.
 - All were in favor.
- Select chairperson Andrews read a letter from the Maine Department of Economic and Community Development stating that they have accepted the Town of Limerick's letter of intent to apply for a Community Development Block Grant for Public Infrastructure.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- John read the announcements.
- Select chairperson Andrews stated that the Door to Door contract will expire December 31, 2018 and they will have to add another warrant article to ask permission to enter into another three year contract.

WARRANTS:

- **A Motion was made and seconded to accept the warrants as presented. All were in favor.**

MEETING ADJOURNED:

- **A Motion made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor.** The Meeting was adjourned at 7:34 p.m.
