ST. JOSEPH SOCIETY MEETING

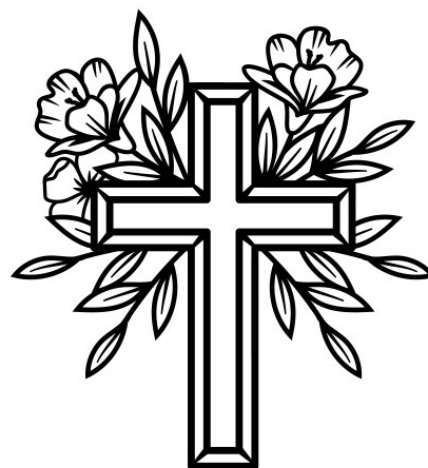
