## Driving within the Transfer Stations

When driving in the Transfer Stations, please obey the speed limit and stay on the roadways provided. This goes a long way to protect everyone on site.

## Barbed Wire (farm fencing wire)

All three transfer stations accept barb wire for recycling; however, the wire must be free of fence posts (wood). Please remove all fence posts from barbed wire prior to bringing the wire to the transfer stations. The metal recycler may refuse the pile otherwise.

## Ag Chemical Containers Up to 23L

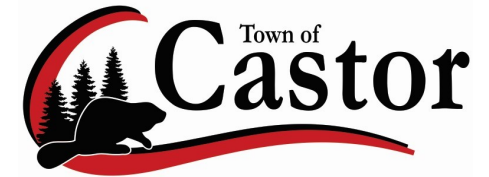
