

BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Meeting Minutes

January 13, 2019

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the meeting with the pledge at 7:05PM.

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

Roland C. LePage, Dorothy M. Richard, Wendy M. Thorne, Gilbert S. Harris, Joanne L. Andrews was absent.

ATTENDEES:

MINUTES:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the minutes for January 6. Gil **second**. **All** were in favor.

OLD BUSINESS:

- The rest of the members of the Board and members of the Fire Department that had to sign the Surplus Property form signed it having approved it at an earlier meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Wendy **motioned** to sign the letter of intent to apply for the additional \$500,000 for the water/sewer on Main Street. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.
- The Board signed the last of the auction lot deeds.
- Dottie **motioned** to approve and sign the Poverty Abatement. **All** were in favor.
- Wendy **motioned** to approve the Junkyard Ordinance to go on the March ballot. Dottie **second**. Three were in favor; Sonny did not raise his hand.
- Dottie **motioned** to approve the Solar Ordinance to be put on the March ballot. Wendy **second**. Gil said that he was not able to review the ordinance so he will abstain. Three were in favor, Gil abstained.
- Wendy **motioned** to put articles 3 through 16 on the secret ballot. Gil **second**. Three were in favor, Sonny did not raise his hand.
- The Board discussed the Southern Maine Gearbots using the Community Room at the Municipal Building for their meetings. Wendy **motioned** to allow them to use the Community Room in the Municipal Building. Sonny **second**. **All** were in favor.
- Wendy brought up that the Budget Committee had requested a joint meeting with the Board and they decided to have it on Thursday, January 30th at 7:00PM.

WARRANT:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the warrant as written. Gil **second**. **All** were in favor.

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ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Dottie read the announcements.

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Steve McLean talked about the gathering that they were going to have on Sunday, February 2nd, from 1 to 3 for Dick McGlincey at the Brick Town Hall. He also brought up having the Board vote to have something put on the ballot about paying state wages for the highway workers. Charles Pellegrino made the comment that state wages are not enough and that he doesn't know who they will get to do the work if the Board decides to go with the state wages. Sonny said that something as crucial as this should be discussed when the whole Board is there but he agrees with what Charles is saying. Charles also made the comment that Steve McLean had put an article in the paper about it and that he would not do the work for state wages. Wendy asked the question if the flagger would be put on the payroll and has the town paid for them before or does the contractor pay them and Sonny said that usually the town pays the flaggers.

- Wendy **motioned** to adjourn. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.
- The Meeting was adjourned at 7:30PM.
