Requirements:

- Personal lived experience of mental health and/or addictions including gambling or online betting
- A level of personal recovery sufficient to complete the training, practicum and groups
- A commitment to the course and your own on-going recovery and self-care
- Understanding of a peer support and recovery perspective
- Comfortable with public speaking and group facilitation

You will gain:

- Peer Support Training
- Facilitation Training
- Gambling Harms Information Training
- Practical Peer Support training and supervision
- Experience facilitating gambling information groups in the community

You must commit to work with us for approximately 8 months, which includes:

- Peer support, facilitation and gambling information training - 16 weeks
- Practicum (practical on-site training) - 6 weeks
- Deliver Two 2-hour community information support sessions on gambling harms
- Note, this is NOT a full time commitment
