



You're invited to a Chown Place Open House

"At Chown Place a new 58-unit building is nearing completion and we expect to begin moving tenants into the building before the end of April.

Erin Sterling, as the Minister of Pilgrim United Church at the time, Alanna Menu and Carol Martin, as former members of the Executive of Victoria Presbytery, will recall Gorge View Society (a non-profit housing society) was given \$300,000 from Pilgrim United when they closed and \$100,000 from Victoria Presbytery to build family housing.

GVS has used this money well with the construction of nine two- and three-bedroom family units on the ground floor of our new Phase 1 building.

The City of Victoria has approved a Master Plan for the Chown Place site. As part of the master plan a Phase 2 development includes nine additional family apartments and nine town house units in a Phase 2 development.

We have recently re-engaged our development consultant and architect to begin design and to prepare the BC Housing funding submission for Phase 2 of the Master Plan. The funding call is expected this fall.

When the Master Plan is fully realised there will be 63 family units at Chown Place.

To acknowledge the part that Pilgrim United and Victoria Presbytery have played in helping to fund family accommodation at Chown Place, GVS would like to extend an invitation to tour our new building and family units.

The tour will be from 1:30 pm—2:30 pm Thursday April 13 at Chown Place.
