

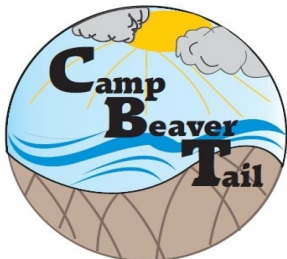
Recreation

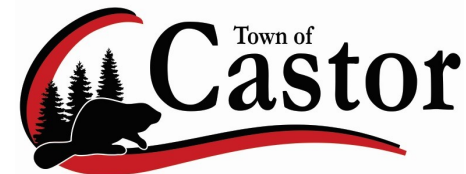
