- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Meeting Highlights of February 1, 2016. Both were in favor.

The Board submitted to the Planning Board for review. The Board takes this matter very seriously and is asking the PB to make this their priority and have it ready to put on the June Ballot.
- A reminder to all committees that have evening meetings to be sure and lock both front doors and the Lobby door upon exiting the building.
- Approved and signed five (5) abatements.
- **Motion made to accept** the renewal of the Town's Carbonite with Modem Wavs, Inc. in the amount of \$599.00 with a 10% discount. New renewal date will change to 07/26/2017. Both were in favor.

- Review emails/insurance from P & C Insurance – Tabled
- **Motion made and seconded** to hire Bob DeVilleneuve to replace wiring and install new outlets (up to \$600.00) in the Planning Board Office. Both were in favor.

- **Motion made and seconded** to sign the Service and Supply Contract from Portland Computer Copy, Inc. Both were in favor.
- **Motion made and seconded** to approve the Librarian to purchase a printer in the amount of \$453.97 to be paid from the Capital Equipment Account. Both were in favor.
- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the proposal from S & S Services to replace the flooring in the upstairs bathroom at the Municipal Building in the amount of \$1,010.00. Both were in favor.
- Proposal from S & S Services to replace flooring in the Planning Board Office was tabled.
