MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

Joanne L. Andrews, John M. Medici and Roland C. Lepage.

ATTENDEES:

- Dottie Richard, Bill Jones, Gil Harris, Ed Harris, Mike Gilpatrick, Steve Malmude.

CALL TO ORDER:

- Joanne called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- **A Motion was made and seconded** to approve the Meeting Highlights of February 12, 2018.
All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Select chairperson Andrews, read the January Fire Department Report.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Mike Gilpatrick – Spoke on behalf of the Limerick Water Department. Mike stated that the water has been tested and it is within the tollerances of the Safe Drinking Water Act. Mike stated that there are ways that the well can be cleaned and the Water Department is investigating that avenue. On behalf of The Water District Mike is asking if the Selectmen can assist in a reimbursement of the funds that were spent on upgrades that were done on School Street last year due to the fact that the road was repaved and the Water and Sewer District was requested to replace man-holes etc.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Selectman Medici Made a motion to approve the abatement for Map 7 Lot 20.**
 - **Selectman LePage seconded the motion.**
 - **All were in favor.**

CONFIDENTIAL BUSINESS:

- Select Chairperson Andrews signed a letter of decision on a poverty abatement.

ASSESSING:

PENDING AND CORRESPONDENCE:

- Selectman Medici asked if the residents on Allaire Drive would need to take out a petition; given the fact that that the select board hasn't affirmed a motion. After some discussion Select chair person Andrews stated that the town needs to speak with the town attorney about what subdivision laws need to be followed, the laws of 1973 or Current Subdivision laws. Mike Gilpatrick will call the attorney regarding this matter.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Selectman LePage read the announcements.

WARRANTS:

- The Select board signed three copies of the Warrant for the 2018 Annual Town Meeting.
- **A Motion was made and seconded to accept the warrants as presented. All were in favor.**

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude stated that he has decided to take the Swim Instructors course and pay for it himself and if the town choses to have him teach any classes in the future they can discuss reimbursement at that time.
- Selectman Medici stated that after reading the Engineers Report on the Brick Town Hall, he doesn't think anyone should be allowed on the seconded and third floors until the fire escape is repaired. The Board decided that it would be best for anyone wanting to rent the Brick Town Hall be required to stay on the first floor level for now.

- **A Motion was made and seconded** to adjourn the meeting. **All were in favor.** The Meeting was adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
