# A history of the Ancient Order of Hibernians

**T**he Ancient Order of Hibernians, known as the A.O.H., is truly an ancient organization having its beginning in Ireland around 1565 AD. The A.O.H. began as a secret society of Irish farmers who formed the order for two reasons: firstly, to serve as a bodyguard for priests and congregations during the celebration of the mass which was then prohibited by the British government, and secondly to bring about the destruction of the unjust system of land ownership in Ireland that had established a small number of largely alien landlords as owners of practically all of the property in the country.

The A.O.H. was brought to America by Irish immigrants. The American branch was founded in 1836. All members are Roman Catholics of Irish descent. The motto of the order is “Friendship, Unity and Christian Charity- Cairdis, agus Aontacht Chríostaí Carthanais”.

The present division or chapter which organizes the St. Patrick’s Parade in Kingston, New York was chartered in May of 1905 and reorganized in December of 1969 and its first president was Eugene P. Whalen. Records show that this was not the first A.O.H. division to exist in Ulster County. We know that there were divisions in Rondout and Port Ewen in the 1850’s and 1860’s. The 1884 A.O.H. directory lists divisions in Rock Lock, Whiteport, Rondout and Kingston, New York. In 1904 divisions were in Whiteport, Rondout and Kingston.

The official holidays of the A.O.H. are St. Patrick’s Day, March 17; Independence Day, July 4th; Our Lady of Knock August 21st; and Commodore John Barry Day, September 13th.

In addition to the St. Patrick’s Parade committee the local A.O.H. has a few other committees that are active throughout the year, including The Catholic Action Committee, The Freedom for All Ireland Committee, The Pro-Life Committee, The Missions Committee, and The Charities Committee. Our division produces “The Irish Show”, a radio program of Irish music aired on WKNY-1490 AM, on Sunday morning at 8:06 A.M. It is co-host-

ed by two genial Hibernians, Ken and Anna Brett. We have published our website at [www.ulsteraoh.com](http://www.ulsteraoh.com), where you can keep current with the activities of our division and listen to the “The Irish Show” all week. The Ulster County AOH Pipes, Drums and Honor Guard and continues to grow and ability. If you want to learn to play the bagpipes, the drums or just join us for good clean fun, contact the AOH and a place will be found for you. Classes can be organized around your schedule. Also, the Hooley on the Hudson™ continues to grow as we celebrate Irish Culture and Customs. The Hooley™ is held on the Rondout; in Kingston —Music, Dancing, Language, Food, and Art. This grand event is held the Sunday of Labor Day Weekend. Over the years, the division has hosted many other social and cultural affairs such as our halfway to St. Patrick’s dinner dance, concerts of Irish music as well as religious events, including a pilgrimage to East Durham, New York to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Knock. In 2008 we dedicated a Celtic Cross to the memory of An Gorta Mor- The Great Starvation of Ireland from 1845 to 1852 and to those Irish who have come before us, came to this country, and helped make it great. We have made the Cross the center piece of our Feed the Hungry Project Committee and have raised money for the hungry of Ulster County, “Is Cuimhin Linn- We Remember”. We have our property for the Irish Cultural Center, Hudson Valley, Inc. Plans are in the works for the construction of a building for the center which we hope to begin this year. We sponsor dance classes, fiddle classes, Irish language classes traditional music sessions, among our various cultural events. In addition, we are establishing a Currach racing team to compete in events held by the North American Currach Association. We continue to promote the culture of the Irish through our activities working in conjunction with Ladies A.O.H. Division 5 of Ulster County and the Irish Cultural Center Hudson Valley. We have begun construction of the Irish Cultural Center Hudson Valley and expect to have the facility phase one up and running by the end of 2021. Our membership presently numbers 191 members mainly from the Kingston and Saugerties area.

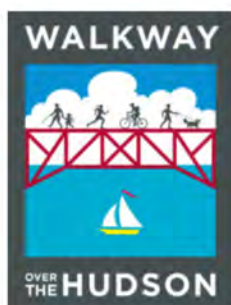

# Brendan Behan

February 1923 – 20 March 1964

**B**rendan Behan, author, playwright, raconteur was born in the north side of Dublin one hundred years ago. He grew up in difficult economic circumstances, the eldest of five children. His family was steeped in the republican tradition as his father Steven Behan had fought in the War of Independence and his uncle was Peadar Kearney, who wrote the *Iris National Amhran Na Bhfiann* (The Soldiers Song). Brendan's love of literature and music was stimulated by his father who knew French and paten and who read selections of his favorite authors to his four sons, the eldest of whom was Brendan.

During his schooldays Brendan showed extraordinary talent in essays and he was also read extensively during this time. He left school at age fourteen and became a painter but in later years he regretted the fact that he did not receive a better education. He joined the youth organization of the I.R.A. at age eight and then at sixteen years he was in the adult ranks of the I.R.A. As part of his commitment to the Republicans cause in November 1939 he travelled to England with explosives without actually getting approval from senior command and shortly after arrival he was detained and charged with possession of explosives. He was sentenced to 3 years Borstal detention. During the next three years Brendan was fortunate enough to meet an understanding governor, C. A. Joyce, who recognized his talents and encouraged him in all his writing activities.

He returned to Dublin after completing his period of Borstal detention. 6 Months later he was involved in the shooting episode at an Easter commemorative ceremony and was sentenced to fourteen of penal servitude in Mountjoy Prison in Dublin. It was during that time that one of the prisoners was executed and this was the back ground for one of his plays, *"The Quare Fellow"*. In December 1946 under general amnesty, he was released from prison. Over the next several years, Brendan became the writer and he also became very involved in the Irish language. He spent some time in Paris and developed his talents as a writer. His three major works were published in the 1950's, *The Quare Fel-*

low, *The Borstal Boy* which was a autobiographical novel based on his time in Borstal detention, and the hostage. This latter play concerned an English soldier stationed in Northern Ireland who was kidnapped by the I.R.A. and brought to Dublin to be executed if a young man under sentence of death was hanged in Belfast. During the 1950's Brendan Behan reached the peak of his fame and reputation as a writer, raconteur, and a man of wit and repartee. Unfortunately, he had developed a liking of alcohol from a very early age and although there were times when he managed to adhere to diet and no alcohol intake, the periods were not durable his recurring bouts of alcohol depending became more and more frequent and as a result he did very little writing in his later years. His medical issues included diabetes myelitis, liver disease and these were all exacerbated by his continued alcohol intake and his inability to change his life style. "I am a drinker with a writing problem"

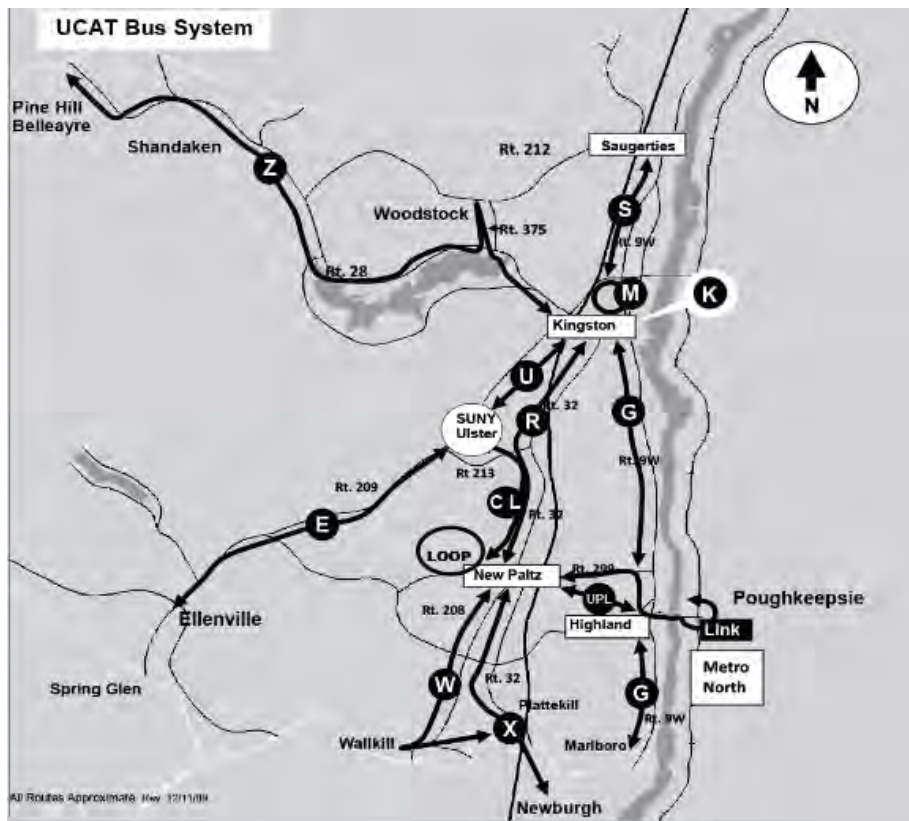
There is little doubt that he was one of the most talented authors and playwrights of 20th century Ireland. Unfortunately, his literary brilliance and immense talent have very often been overshadowed by his human frailties. None the less, he is one of the major Irish literary figures of the 20th century. Brendan died in Dublin hospital in March 1964 at the age of forty-one.

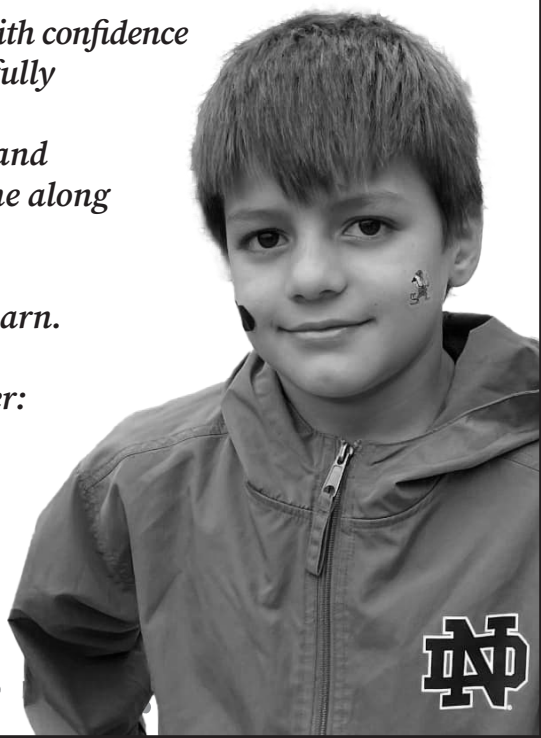

## Achieving A Green Building – the Goal of the Irish Cultural Center

We will promote and preserve our literature, music, dance, stories, poetry, art, drama, crafts, and history, and pass our culture down to successive generations. Our goal also is to serve as a testament to the contributions and sacrifices made by our ancestors in helping to build this region of the country, and to honor all they accomplished in keeping the Irish spirit strong. We look to provide a warm and welcoming place for all who want to share in, or learn about, our great Irish-American culture.

# FATHER CORNELIUS COLBERT Woulfe C. S. Sp.

The Ancient Order of Hibernians, Division One Ulster County is named in honor of Fr. Cornelius Colbert Woulfe C. S. Sp., a humble, gentle, man of great faith.

A native of Abbeyfeale, County Limerick, Woulfe was educated at the National Schoole of Abbeyfeale and Rockwell College in County Tipperary. After graduating from both the National University of Ireland and the Holy Ghost Missionary College in Dublin, he was ordained a priest of the Holy Ghost Fathers on July 16, 1944.

On completion of his studies in 1945, Fr. Woulfe was assigned to Nigeria where he taught in the College of the Immaculate Conception in 1946, then served as education secretary for the Archdiocese

of Onitsha from 1947 to 1970. During the civil war between the Biafran Igbo and the Nigerian Federal forces from 1967 to 1970, he served as a missionary with the Irish Holy Ghost Fathers. As the war progressed, the Igbo congregations, along with Fr. Woulfe, were forced into Biafran territory as the Federal forces encircled them. Despite a 1968 Vatican mission to Biafra, where Pope Paul VI personally spoke out on behalf of the Biafran Igbo. Missionaries who supported the Biafran Igbo were expelled following the war—roughly 500 total—and no foreign priests were permitted to work in Nigeria until the mid-1970s.

Once expelled from Nigeria, Fr. Woulfe came to the United States in 1971 as the Superior of the Irish Holy Ghost Fathers in the U.S. For the next 25 years, he resided at St. Mary's Church and served as chaplain at Kingston Hospital. He served for many years as chaplain of the Division



One, Ulster County Ancient Order of Hibernians which is now named in his honor.

In 1990, Fr. Woulfe served as co-Grand Marshal of the Kingston St. Patrick's Day Parade. The 1995 and 2001 St. Patrick's Day Parades were dedicated to him as well. As the dedication in 2001 said, he had a distinct love of Irish Heritage. "He is small in stature, but large in

presence, quiet of voice, but booming in the message of faith that he so eloquently imparts. He passed that love on, while he was here with us in his soft brogue and gentle manner. While we can't hear his voice now, the message is with us still." He was. We extend our heartfelt sympathy and condolences to his family. May eternal rest grant unto him O Lord and perpetual light shine upon him.



Fr. Woulfe is a descendant of Cornelius Colbert, his uncle and namesake. As one of the martyrs of the Easter Uprising that led to establishment of the Irish Free State, Woulfe, was executed by the British in 1916 for his part in the Easter Week Uprising. This following poem was written in 1915 by Cornelius Colbert:

May sharp swords fall on Ireland's foe,  
May all her hills be rifle-lined,  
May I be there to deal a blow  
For Ireland, Faith and Womankind.

God's good mercy, if I fall  
And Ireland, strongly free.  
If I live and Ireland lives,  
Oh! God is very good to me.

And may the song of battle soon  
Be heard from every hill and vale.  
May I be there with the marching men,  
Who fight to free our Grainne Mhaol.

# Who was Saint Patrick?

Look at a calendar and you'll find holidays marked on certain days. For example, Americans celebrate Martin Luther King's birthday in January, President's Day in February and Independence Day on the Fourth of July. All of these holidays are related to important events in American history. But on the calendar for March you'll find that March 17 is St. Patrick's Day.

In the Catholic Church, St. Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland. Since so many Irish people immigrated to the United States and celebrated St. Patrick's Day after they arrived, St. Patrick's Day has been assimilated (become a part of) American culture and lots of people do special things for this holiday.

St. Patrick lived in the fourth century A.D. It's hard to know exactly when he was born so long ago but it is known that he was born in Britain and that his parents were wealthy. When Patrick was sixteen his family estate was attacked by Irish robbers and they took Patrick back to Ireland as a prisoner where he stayed in captivity for six years. During this time Patrick worked as a shepherd and it is reported that he became a devout Christian. He claimed that God told him to leave Ireland and managed to escape his captors.

Patrick made his way back to Britain. After returning to Britain, Patrick believed that an angel appeared to him in a dream to tell him to become a missionary in Ireland. After fifteen years of study, he became a priest and then returned to Ireland to convert people to Christianity. Other stories about St. Pat-

rick call him a bishop and say that he built schools, churches and monasteries. Without good written records, it's hard to know some of the exact details but legends abound.

One legend says that St. Patrick drove the snakes out of Ireland. But scientists tell us that Ireland, which is an island, didn't have any snakes to begin with. The Druids were pagans in Ireland who used the serpent as a symbol and perhaps converting them to Christianity could be considered as driving out snakes. It's believed that St. Patrick died on March 17 which is why we celebrate St. Patrick's Day on that date.
