

BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Meeting Highlights

July 30, 2018

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the Meeting at 7:00 PM with the flag salute.

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Selectman Richard made a motion to approve the Meeting Highlights for July 23, 2018 with one correction. Selectman Thorne seconded the motion. The vote passed 5-0**

OLD BUSINESS:

- Dangerous intersection at Raptor Ridge Road and Enterprise Road.
 - Select chairman LePage stated that the road commissioner cleared a lot of the brush and is checking into taking out more. Selectman Thorne suggested that the town put up a sign stating “Blind Drive” **Selectman Thorne made a motion to put a sign stating “Blind Drive” before Raptor Ridge Road. Selectman Richard seconded the motion. All were in favor.**

 - **After much discussion the Select Board stated that they need to set up a Workshop.**
- Approve Request for Bids ad for Snow Removal on Washington Street.

- Update – Item 01-18-03-B Water Intrusion: MMA’s Recommendation- Investigate the water intrusion evidence in the front wall of the Brick Town Hall at the third level of the stairs to ensure that no water is leaking into the building and that mold is not present.
