

## November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2006 Meeting - Speaker's Biography:

Chris Snow is currently the Manager of Service and Inspection for Enbridge Gas New Brunswick, and has been employed in the propane natural gas industry for the past 31 years. Enbridge Gas New Brunswick is a partnership between Enbridge Inc. with 64% shares and local New Brunswick investors with 36% shares. In 1999 the company was given a 20 year franchise to develop and deliver natural gas to the New Brunswick market. Chris sits on the New Brunswick Compressed Gas Board as the representative for the natural gas industry ,and is a member of The New Brunswick Boiler and Pressure Vessel Advisory Committee. At the National level he is a member of the CSA B149 Installation Code Committee, and the B149.3-00 Code for the Field Approval of Fuel-Related Components on Appliances and Equipment. Chris is a Remedial Measures Advisor (RMA) for the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Emergency Response Corporation (LPGERC) which responds to LPG transportation incidents on behalf of its membership through out Canada.

Chris is married with two children and two granddaughters. He is involved in building and flying radio controlled airplanes and enjoys golf and motorcycle riding.

#### Abstract:

Chris Snow will discuss the various venting requirements for natural gas equipment, and given an overview to the B149 Code regarding venting requirements based the intent and rationale of the various clauses.

#### Summary of October 11, 2006 Meeting

Mr. Illya Kornobis, Sales Manager for Royal Quickstop Fireprotection Systems Company, discussed the advantages of a ULC listed fire insulation wrap system designed to meet NFPA 96 requirements for ventilation air duct fire protection and grease duct systems tested to zero clearance from combustibles.

Several methods of installation and jointing were shown. Not all products have the same characteristics, and it is vital that installation be compliant with specific manufacturer's instructions.

Fire wraps are used to contain a fire in a grease duct, or to prevent a fire in a plenum space from entering a ventilation duct. Several typical examples for each situation were shown. It is worth noting that fire wrap products are not ULC listed by themselves, but are actually tested as an installed **system** in a lab.

Prior to the meeting, ASHRAE Society awards were presented to Chuck Edwards for his leadership in Research Promotion last year. Ken Martin, past president, received Society awards for being the best chapter of our size (100-200 members) in five of the six categories last year. Check out the next page for some recent photos. 


